1. "I kept looking Until thrones were set up, And the Ancient of Days took His seat; His vesture was like white snow And the hair of His head like pure wool. His throne was ablaze with flames, Its wheels were a burning fire. "A river of fire was flowing And coming out from before Him; Thousands upon thousands were attending Him, And myriads upon myriads were standing before Him; **The court sat, And the books were opened.** - Daniel 7:9-10 NASU
 - God has a court room.
 - (Tweet) God judges from many books.
2. This is the **book of the generations of Adam**. In the day when God created man, He made him in the likeness of God. He created them male and female, and He blessed them and named them Man in the day when they were created. - Genesis 5:1-2 NASU
 - It appears this is the book that Jesus is the rightful King.
3. Then Moses came and recounted to the people all the words of the Lord and all the ordinances; and all the people answered with one voice and said, "All the words which the Lord has spoken we will do!" Moses wrote down all the words of the Lord. Then he arose early in the morning, and built an altar at the foot of the mountain with twelve pillars for the twelve tribes of Israel. He sent young men of the sons of Israel, and they offered burnt offerings and sacrificed young bulls as peace offerings to the Lord. Moses took half of the blood and put it in basins, and the other half of the blood he sprinkled on the altar. Then he took **the book of the covenant** and read it in the hearing of the people; and they said, "All that the Lord has spoken we will do, and we will be obedient!" So Moses took the blood and sprinkled it on the people, and said, "Behold the blood of the covenant, which the Lord has made with you in accordance with all these words." - Exodus 24:3-8 NASU
 - Also known has the Book of Moses
 - Also known as the Book of the Law
 - This is a book that shuts every mouth.
4. Your eyes have seen my unformed substance; And **in Your book were all written The days that were ordained for me**, When as yet there was not one of them. - Psalms 139:16 NASU
 - This is my conjecture based on scripture.
 - God has a book or a chapter, on every one of us.
 - How did God write a book of the days of our lives before we were and still give us freedom to choose?
 - What God has written but we do not do is blotted out.
 - The book starts with who begat us, then begins the day we follow Jesus.
 - (Tweet) You won't read about me until 28 years of age. My first 27 years is unknown in Heaven. Just that I was born of man then 28 years later born of God. Then all my God deeds.
 - Some people may be a paragraph; others may have a gospel.
 - (Tweet) Only our good deeds, out of love, preordained by God, are written in this book.
5. Then those who feared the Lord spoke to one another, and the Lord gave attention and heard it, and **a book of remembrance** was written before Him for those who fear the Lord and who esteem His name. "They will

be Mine," says the Lord of hosts, "on the day that I prepare My own possession, and **I will spare them as a man spares his own son** who serves him." **So you will again distinguish between the righteous and the wicked, between one who serves God and one who does not serve Him.** - Malachi 3:16-18 NASU

- (Tweet) Every good deed we have ever done is written in this book.
 - Remember in the book of Esther? Mordechai's good deed for the king?
 - Possibly this book is the book of those going in the Rapture.
 - Jesus is coming back for those who are working the works of God, waiting and longing for Him to return.
 - Remember the parable of the wicked slave who left his post because he thought the master was late in coming?
6. I saw in the right hand of Him who sat on the throne a book written inside and on the back, sealed up with seven seals. And I saw a strong angel proclaiming with a loud voice, **"Who is worthy to open the book and to break its seals?"** And no one in heaven or on the earth or under the earth was able to open the book or to look into it. Then I began to weep greatly because no one was found worthy to open the book or to look into it; and one of the elders said to me, "Stop weeping; behold, the Lion that is from the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has overcome so as to open the book and its seven seals." - Revelation 5:1-5 NASU
- (Tweet) Some One better qualify to open the Book of Life.
 - (Tweet) Jesus is worthy to open the Book of Life.
7. and nothing unclean, and no one who practices abomination and lying, shall ever come into it, but only those whose names are written in the **Lamb's book of life.** - Revelation 21:27 NASU
- Book of Life belongs to Jesus.
8. Then I saw a great white throne and Him who sat upon it, from whose presence earth and heaven fled away, and no place was found for them. And I saw the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne, and **books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life; and the dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds.** And the sea gave up the dead which were in it, and death and Hades gave up the dead which were in them; and they were judged, every one of them according to their deeds. Then death and Hades were thrown into the lake of fire. This is the second death, the lake of fire. And if anyone's name was **not found written in the book of life, he was thrown into the lake of fire.** - Revelation 20:11-15 NASU
- Many books were opened.
 - Book of the Living: every person who ever lived and their deeds.
 - Book of Life only has the names of those who received Jesus.

Blotted Out

9. On the next day Moses said to the people, "You yourselves have committed a great sin; and now I am going up to the Lord, perhaps I can make atonement for your sin." Then Moses returned to the Lord, and said, "Alas, **this people has committed a great sin, and they have made a god of gold for themselves.** "But now, if You will, forgive their sin — and if not, **please blot me out from Your book which You have written!**" The Lord said to Moses, **"Whoever has sinned against Me, I will blot him out of My book.** "But go now, lead the people where I told you. Behold, My angel shall go before you; nevertheless in the day when I punish, I will punish them for their sin." Then the Lord smote the people, because of what they did with the calf which Aaron had made. - Exodus 32:30-35 NASU
- Moses asks to be blotted out of the Book of the Living.
 - Blotted out from underneath Heaven. Is used often in scripture.

10. "To the angel of the church in Sardis write: He who has the seven Spirits of God and the seven stars, says this: 'I know your deeds, that you have a name that you are alive, but you are dead. 'Wake up, and strengthen the things that remain, which were about to die; for **I have not found your deeds completed in the sight of My God.** 'So remember what you have received and heard; and keep it, and repent. Therefore if you do not wake up, I will come like a thief, and you will not know at what hour I will come to you. 'But you have a few people in Sardis who have not soiled their garments; and they will walk with Me in white, for they are worthy. **'He who overcomes will thus be clothed in white garments; and I will not erase his name from the book of life,** and I will confess his name before My Father and before His angels. 'He who has an ear, let him hear what the Spirit says to the churches.' - Revelation 3:1-6 NASU

- (Tweet) Quite possible every person was written in the Lamb's Book of life before the foundation of the world.
- (Tweet) Names may be blotted out at the moment of death if the person did not turn to Jesus.
- What deeds do we need to complete to make sure we are not blotted out?
- Repentance is turning from sin to God through the sacrifice of Jesus.
- What have you seen and heard?
 - This is your judgment.
 - Wake up.
 - When you turn out the lights it is to go to sleep.
