But I say, walk by the Spirit, and you will not carry out the desire of the flesh. For the flesh sets its desire against the Spirit, and the Spirit against the flesh; for these are in opposition to one another, so that you may not do the things that you please. But if you are led by the Spirit, you are not under the Law. Now the deeds of the flesh are evident, which are: immorality, impurity, sensuality, idolatry, sorcery, enmities, strife, jealousy, outbursts of anger, disputes, dissensions, factions, envying, drunkenness, carousing, and things like these, of which I forewarn you, just as I have forewarned you, that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness, self-control; against such things there is no law. Now those who belong to Christ Jesus have crucified the flesh with its passions and desires. - Galatians 5:16-24 NASU

PEACE

1. **And the way of peace have they not known: There is no fear of God before their eyes.** - Romans 3:17-18 KJV
2. "But the Helper, the Holy Spirit, whom the Father will send in My name, He will teach you all things, and bring to your remembrance all that I said to you. **"Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you; not as the world gives do I give to you.** Do not let your heart be troubled, nor let it be fearful. - John 14:26-27 NASU
3. So, as those who have been chosen of God, holy and beloved, put on a heart of compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience; bearing with one another, and forgiving each other, whoever has a complaint against anyone; just as the Lord forgave you, so also should you. Beyond all these things put on love, which is the perfect bond of unity. **Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, to which indeed you were called in one body; and be thankful.** Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God. Whatever you do in word or deed, do all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks through Him to God the Father. - Colossians 3:12-17 NASU
4. keep your tongue from evil and your lips from speaking lies. Turn from evil and do good; **seek peace and pursue it.** The eyes of the Lord are on the righteous and his ears are attentive to their cry; the face of the Lord is against those who do evil, to cut off the memory of them from the earth. - Psalms 34:13-16 NIV

CREATING PEACE

5. **"Blessed are the peacemakers, for they shall be called sons of God.** - Matthew 5:9 NASU
6. For they that are after the flesh do mind the things of the flesh; but they that are after the Spirit the things of the Spirit. For to be carnally minded is death; but to be **spiritually minded is life and peace.** Because the carnal mind is enmity against God: for it is not subject to the law of God, neither indeed can be. - Romans 8:5-7 KJV
7. Therefore do not let what is for you a good thing be spoken of as evil; for the **kingdom of God is not eating and drinking, but righteousness and peace and joy in the Holy Spirit.** For he who in this way serves Christ is acceptable to God and approved by men. So then we pursue the things which make for peace and the building up of one another. - Romans 14:16-19 NASU
8. Love and faithfulness meet together; **righteousness and peace kiss each other.** - Psalms 85:10 NIV

9. Seven times a day I praise you for your righteous laws. **Great peace have they who love your law, and nothing can make them stumble.** I wait for your salvation, O Lord, and I follow your commands. - Psalms 119:164-166 NIV
10. In that day this song will be sung in the land of Judah: "We have a strong city; He sets up walls and ramparts for security. **“Open the gates, that the righteous nation may enter, The one that remains faithful. The steadfast of mind You will keep in perfect peace, Because he trusts in You.** "Trust in the Lord forever, For in God the Lord, we have an everlasting Rock. - Isaiah 26:1-4 NASU
11. Who among you is wise and understanding? Let him show by his good behavior his deeds in the gentleness of wisdom. But if you have bitter jealousy and selfish ambition in your heart, do not be arrogant and so lie against the truth. This wisdom is not that which comes down from above, but is earthly, natural, demonic. For where jealousy and selfish ambition exist, there is disorder and every evil thing. But the **wisdom from above is first pure, then peaceable,** gentle, reasonable, full of mercy and good fruits, unwavering, without hypocrisy. And **the seed whose fruit is righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.** - James 3:13-18 NASU
12. For they that are such serve not our Lord Jesus Christ, but their own belly; and by good words and fair speeches deceive the hearts of the simple. For your obedience is come abroad unto all men. I am glad therefore on your behalf: but yet I would have you wise unto that which is good, and simple concerning evil. And **the God of peace shall bruise Satan under your feet shortly.** The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ be with you. Amen. - Romans 16:18-20 KJV

KEEPING YOUR PEACE

13. "And whatever city or village you enter, inquire who is worthy in it, and stay at his house until you leave that city. **“As you enter the house, give it your greeting. "If the house is worthy, give it your blessing of peace. But if it is not worthy, take back your blessing of peace.** - Matthew 10:11-13 NASU
14. **But if the unbelieving depart, let him depart. A brother or a sister is not under bondage in such cases: but God hath called us to peace.** - 1 Corinthians 7:15 KJV
15. **Do not fret because of evil men or be envious of those who do wrong; for like the grass they will soon wither, like green plants they will soon die away.** Trust in the Lord and do good; dwell in the land and enjoy safe pasture. Delight yourself in the Lord and he will give you the desires of your heart. Commit your way to the Lord; trust in him and he will do this: He will make your righteousness shine like the dawn, the justice of your cause like the noonday sun. Be still before the Lord and wait patiently for him; do not fret when men succeed in their ways, when they carry out their wicked schemes. Refrain from anger and turn from wrath; do not fret — it leads only to evil. For evil men will be cut off, but those who hope in the Lord will inherit the land. 16. Let love be without hypocrisy. Abhor what is evil; cling to what is good. Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor; not lagging behind in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord; rejoicing in hope, persevering in tribulation, devoted to prayer, contributing to the needs of the saints, practicing hospitality. Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. Rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those who weep. Be of the same mind toward one

another; do not be haughty in mind, but associate with the lowly. Do not be wise in your own estimation. Never pay back evil for evil to anyone. Respect what is right in the sight of all men. **If possible, so far as it depends on you, be at peace with all men.** Never take your own revenge, beloved, but leave room for the wrath of God, for it is written, "VENGEANCE IS MINE, I WILL REPAY," says the Lord. "BUT IF YOUR ENEMY IS HUNGRY, FEED HIM, AND IF HE IS THIRSTY, GIVE HIM A DRINK; FOR IN SO DOING YOU WILL HEAP BURNING COALS ON HIS HEAD." Do not be overcome by evil, but overcome evil with good. - Romans 12:9-21 NASU

17. **Be careful for nothing;** but in everything by prayer and supplication with thanksgiving let your requests be made known unto God. **And the peace of God, which passeth all understanding, shall keep your hearts and minds through Christ Jesus.** - Philippians 4:6-7 KJV
18. **"Do not think that I came to bring peace on the earth; I did not come to bring peace, but a sword.** "For I came to SET A MAN AGAINST HIS FATHER, AND A DAUGHTER AGAINST HER MOTHER, AND A DAUGHTER-IN-LAW AGAINST HER MOTHER-IN-LAW; and A MAN'S ENEMIES WILL BE THE MEMBERS OF HIS HOUSEHOLD. "He who loves father or mother more than Me is not worthy of Me; and he who loves son or daughter more than Me is not worthy of Me. "And he who does not take his cross and follow after Me is not worthy of Me. "He who has found his life will lose it, and he who has lost his life for My sake will find it. - Matthew 10:34-39 NASU
19. For it was the Father's good pleasure for all the fullness to dwell in Him, and through Him to reconcile all things to Himself, **having made peace through the blood of His cross; through Him,** I say, whether things on earth or things in heaven. And although you were formerly alienated and hostile in mind, engaged in evil deeds, yet He has now reconciled you in His fleshly body through death, in order to present you before Him holy and blameless and beyond reproach — if indeed you continue in the faith firmly established and steadfast, and not moved away from the hope of the gospel that you have heard, which was proclaimed in all creation under heaven, and of which I, Paul, was made a minister. - Colossians 1:19-23 NASU
20. Who hath believed our report? and to whom is the arm of the Lord revealed? For he shall grow up before him as a tender plant, and as a root out of a dry ground: he hath no form nor comeliness; and when we shall see him, there is no beauty that we should desire him. He is despised and rejected of men; a man of sorrows, and acquainted with grief: and we hid as it were our faces from him; he was despised, and we esteemed him not. Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted. But he was wounded for our transgressions, he was bruised for our iniquities: **the chastisement of our peace was upon him;** and with his stripes we are healed. - Isaiah 53:1-5 KJV

Eternity: Heaven or Hell

God placed **ETERNITY** in the hearts of men. How your life ends is more important than how your life began. You may have started life in a religion or philosophy, rich or poor, or even in a Christian home. But do you know Jesus, the Savior of the world? And does He know you?

God created man to live forever and not die. However, when sin entered the human race, every man was given once to live, die, and face judgment. Your body will one day die, but you will live on for an eternity in one of two places.

Scripture References: Ecclesiastes 3:11, John 5:29, Matthew 24:26, Romans 1:18-22

HEAVEN is for those who have acknowledged their sinful nature and a need for a Savior. They have put their trust in Jesus Christ and His finished work on the cross without adding anything to it. Heaven is for those who love God; those who love Him with all their heart, soul, mind, and strength and love one another as they do themselves. Heaven is a dwelling place with God, where all needs are met, desires satisfied, tears wiped away, and obedience rewarded.

Scripture References: 1 Peter 1:3-4, Hebrews 9:24, John 14:1-4, Col 1:3-5, Luke 11:2, Luke 6:22-23, Revelation 21:4

HELL is for those who refused to love the Truth, do not know God, and did not accept the gift of salvation through Jesus Christ. Hell is for those who disobey God's commandments, condemning themselves by their own words and evil deeds. Hell is a dwelling place without God, where needs go unmet, desires go unfulfilled, all pain goes uncomforted, and disobedience is punished forever and ever to the degree a sinful life was lived.

Do you know God?

God is a good God. He created a perfect world and then created man to rule this world as He rules the Heavens. However, the first man, Adam, sinned against God and the whole world fell into sin and out of fellowship with God.

Now all the earth is considered as a lost coin worth finding; a treasure worth redeeming and the souls of men worth saving.

Listen, my friend, you have value and purpose in the eyes of God. God created you for good and not evil. Since God is not a man nor has flesh that gives up and walks away from a challenge; He has a plan of eternal salvation for your life even while you are yet a sinner disregarding His commandments.

No matter how many times you have sinned or how bad your sin, God has not changed His mind to save your soul. God wants to save your soul but also save all that was lost through the consequences of sin: your health, finances, relationships, purpose, and more.

However, you must understand that because you have sinned, as have I, all must face death. But because God is merciful, he has given every man one life to live, die and then face judgment. To receive the plan and promise(s) of God, you must place your trust in the Truth, while you yet live: His plan of salvation through His Son, Jesus Christ is the only way to receive eternal life.

"This is eternal life, that they may know You, the only true God, and Jesus Christ whom You have sent.

- John 17:3 NASU

For God so loved YOU: He gave and required His Only Son to come to Earth live a perfect sinless life, obey all the laws of Moses and the Prophets, and only do the will of His Heavenly Father. Jesus' being crucified on the cross for sins He did not commit was part of that obedience to God. Jesus was an innocent man! But God thought it only fair for one man to pay for the sins of the world since it was by one man who brought sin into the world.

"For God so loved the world, that He gave His only begotten Son, that whoever believes in Him shall not perish, but have eternal life. For God did not send the Son into the world to judge the world, but that the world might be saved through Him"

- **John 3:16-17 NASU**

God didn't stop there—after Jesus was dead, His body laid in a tomb, His soul given to the depths of the earth, God thought it even better to raise Jesus from the dead to give us who are already dead in our sins a new heart, a new spirit and a promise we too will be raised to eternal life.

And it has been made simple for us to receive this eternal life. We must see our need for a Savior. So today, turn from your sin and confess Jesus as the new Lord of your life. When you believe in your heart and confess with your mouth that Jesus was raised from the dead and is alive today you begin a life of salvation.

Salvation is good news! Don't you think? Do you know any other way to be saved? Is there any other God that has given his own life to save humanity from sin and destruction? I don't think so! No, there is no other God!

Please read and think upon the following two quotes spoken by Jesus in the Holy Scriptures:

"Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

- **Matthew 11:28-30 NIV**

Jesus said to him, "I am the way, and the truth, and the life; no one comes to the Father but through Me.

- **John 14:6 NASU**

...how I did not shrink from declaring to you anything that was profitable, and teaching you publicly and from house to house, solemnly testifying to both Jews and Greeks of repentance toward God and faith in our Lord Jesus Christ.

- **Acts 20:20-21 NASU**

...that if you confess with your mouth Jesus as Lord, and believe in your heart that God raised Him from the dead, you will be saved; for with

the heart a person believes, resulting in righteousness, and with the mouth he confesses, resulting in salvation.

- Romans 10:9-10 NASU

Are you ready to be forgiven and receive eternal life? If so, pray this prayer like they are your own words.

Heavenly Father forgive me for I have sinned against You. I stand guilty and humbled. I need a Savior, and I understand You have provided One. You gave your own Son Jesus Christ to die on the cross to take away my sin and receive my due punishment. You also raised Him from the dead so that I could receive the gift of eternal life. Because of Your sacrifice, I receive this forgiveness and will go and sin no more. As I learn your ways, I will confess my sin knowing that you are faithful and justified to forgive me and cleanse me of all unrighteousness; in the name of Jesus in whom there is no other name, I can be saved. **Amen.**

Praise God! You are now forgiven of your sins and have inherited eternal life. You might not know what all that means yet. But you can know that you are not going to Hell and that in of itself is good to know, don't you think?

Now, when someone asks you why you are in high spirits—tell them. Tell them your sins have been forgiven through Jesus Christ and that is why you are of good cheer.

LOVE

WORSHIP

Worship begins with gratitude. Thank God for everything that He has done in your life from the least to the greatest. Next, praise Him. Praise Him for all that He is: He is faithful, generous, patient, merciful, kind and loving. Continually worship Him in a life of action and deed with your unconditional obedience to Him.

PRAYER

Prayer is to have a two-way conversation with God. Pray in the morning is to receive God's peace and wisdom for the day. Pray in the evening to release all your cares to Him. Pray all the time to share all your life with Him. Pray while kneeling and standing, walking, and driving, working, and playing. Pray, God will answer.

FORGIVE

Forgiveness means to let go of an offense and let God be the judge, jury, and executioner. Let go of bitterness and resentment and think no more upon it. Remember, God first forgave us so that we may forgive others.

MEDITATE

Meditation is to apply the Word of God in your life by thinking it through. Meditating on the Word of God will transform your thinking all the way through to your everyday actions. It is the Word of God that makes one wise unto salvation, so read the Bible regularly, and you will have plenty to meditate.

GIVING

Giving to those who lack is a sure sign of Christ in you. Give with a cheerful heart and purpose to show that Jesus is indeed alive and well. Whatever you have in abundance give liberally to those who lack. And most of all give your testimony.

GO TO CHURCH

The Church is a fellowship of people who believe God speaks to His people today through the Holy Spirit, confirming the authenticity of the original Scriptures. Commit to a fellowship where they will love you and not condemn; people who will challenge you to live a holy and fruitful life for the Kingdom of God.

Scripture References: Matthew 16:18, Acts 2:46, Matthew 18:20

Holy Spirit

Confirming the kingdom of God

Jesus, in this very present moment, in His resurrected and glorified body, is seated at the right hand of the Father. A position where he continually makes intercession for us and doing all that we ask in His Name according to The Father's will and our abiding in the Truth.

When we receive Jesus as our Savior and Lord, we receive His name along with His authority to preach the gospel. We also welcome the Father and His gift of a new spirit and a new heart. And we too received the Holy Spirit who begins His work from within to make us holy and fruitful for the kingdom of God.

However, the Holy Spirit has more to offer than the inner work of our salvation. There is an outer work of the Holy Spirit as well, and some call this the 'Baptism of the Holy Spirit.'

When we receive the 'Baptism of the Holy Spirit,' we receive His Power and gifts, which confirm the Kingdom of God has indeed come. Through His power, we can cast out demons, heal the sick, raise the dead and speak with new tongues.

"These signs will accompany those who have believed: in My name they will cast out demons, they will speak with new tongues; ... they will lay hands on the sick, and they will recover."

- **Mark 16:17-18 NASU**

Without having performed a miracle, John the Baptist still preached the gospel, and many believed. There are many preachers and Christians who do the same, praise God! However, Jesus preached the gospel with miracle after miracle, and many more believed. Some people will not accept salvation unless they first know that the gospel we preach has a supernatural power to change lives now! The kingdom of God does not come in word but power!

In scripture, Jesus promised that if we would ask of our Father for His Holy Spirit that He would come to us. Jesus then demonstrated this promise by casting a demon out of a deaf and dumb man who could then hear and speak. Jesus also healed many who were sick and raised the dead several times, all by the Holy Spirit's power.

We need the 'Baptism of the Holy Spirit' to confirm our gospel of hope.

If we preach the gospel to them that have ears to hear—they will be saved. If we preach the gospel with signs and wonders to them that are blind and deaf—they too will be saved. If we cast out demons, speak with new tongues and heal the sick—we confirm that the Kingdom of God has come.

Now don't get hung-up on speaking in tongues. The 'Baptism of the Holy Spirit' is for you and me to receive the power to confirm the Kingdom of God. Don't allow a manifestation to be an offense and keep you from receiving Him. He will not give you anything you don't want. I, however, do speak in tongues and the Holy Spirit rewards me for doing so.

For John truly baptized with water; but ye shall be baptized with the Holy Ghost not many days hence... But ye shall receive power,

after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you: and ye shall be witnesses unto me both in Jerusalem, and in all Judaea, and in Samaria, and unto the uttermost part of the earth.

- Acts 1:5, 8 KJV

Unsure how to receive the 'Baptism of The Holy Spirit'? Allow me to lead you in prayer:

Heavenly Father, in the name of Jesus, I ask for this 'Baptism of the Holy Spirit' to come upon my life so that I might confirm the kingdom of God with signs and wonders. Father, I believe, and I receive this baptism to lead me in power to demonstrate the gospel of the resurrected Jesus Christ. I have faith that as I worship, you will confirm I have asked accordingly to your will with a new heavenly language. **Amen.**

Begin worshipping God and receive a new language and power.

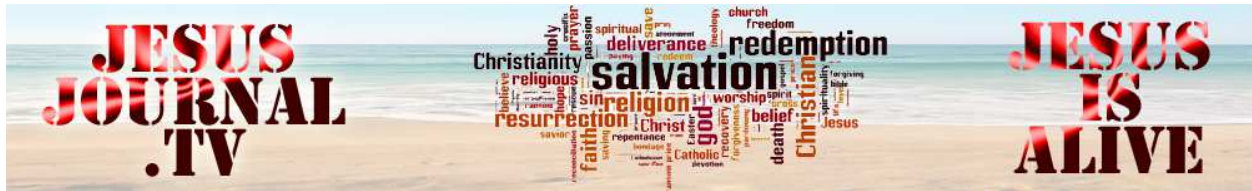
